Whether they created public plazas or private retreats, each of the eight landscape architects featured in the upcoming LALH conference "Masters of Modern Landscape Design" asserted a distinct artistic vision. What they shared, from Dan Kiley and Garrett Eckbo to Ruth Shellhorn and Lawrence Halprin, was assertiveness itself—the boldness to break with Beaux Arts tradition and embrace designs they believed were relevant to the modern condition.
